# MEET THE SPEAKERS

## Kevin Dhuyvetter

Kevin Dhuyvetter assists farmers, land-owners, and others throughout Kansas with risk and return assessment of alternative crop and livestock production and marketing systems. He works extensively with land-related issues such as buying and leasing land. Current research and extension efforts are examining relationships between energy prices and crop inputs, estimating crop yield and fertilizer and water relationships, economics of no-tillage, the economics of grazing systems, and factors affecting feeder cattle prices and basis. One of Kevin's trademarks is his development of decision tools that can be used by clientele for helping them with the myriad of decisions they face in their operations.

## Jeff Davidson

Jeff Davidson has been the Greenwood County Extension Agricultural agent for 32 years. In that position he develops and implements research-based educational programs for agricultural, 4-H and community development issues.

## Charlie Lee

Charlie Lee has been employed by K-State Research and Extension for 17 years, first as an extension assistant and for the last 14 years as Extension Specialist, Wildlife. Responsibilities include conducting a statewide program in wildlife damage control, wildlife enhancement on private lands, youth outdoor environmental programs, and aquaculture. Current areas of interest include prairie dog and cattle interactions, bird damage control at feedlots and rodent damage in conservation tillage systems. Charlie previously worked for Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks directing private land wildlife management programs and Farm Bill conservation issues.

## Hannah Berns

Hannah Berns has a business degree from the University of Kansas and a masters degree from Kansas State University in agricultural economics. She now works for the Southeast Kansas Farm Management Association in the El Dorado office. As a KFMA economist she works cooperatively with farm families to provide members with production and financial management information for use in decision making.
