

Connecting Livestock Producers with Economic Research

Objective:

Connecting Livestock Producers with Economic Research (CLPER) is a Kansas State University publication authored by [Dr. Glynn Tonsor](#) released to enhance the dissemination of information from peer-reviewed economic research articles to livestock industry decision makers. CLPER seeks to synthesize recent economic research in order to inform decision-making of livestock producers.

Distribution Method, Frequency, and Format:

Issues of CLPER will be concisely written as 2-4 page documents summarizing key findings and economic implications for livestock producers of 4-6 academic journal articles published in recent months. CLPER will be posted for free downloading from [Kansas State University's AgManager](#) website and be available for e-mail distribution for those interested in notification of new postings. When applicable, links to journal articles that are available to the general public will be included.

Intended Value and Need:

Livestock producers are increasingly in need of the most recent research on a host of economic issues. Meanwhile, researchers worldwide are publishing an increasing number of peer-reviewed journal articles that livestock producers infrequently benefit from directly. CLPER seeks to fill this gap by facilitating a wider distribution of peer-reviewed journal article information on economic issues of interest to modern livestock producers and other industry decision makers.
