

Historical and Projected Kansas Feedlot Net Returns

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This article presents estimated net returns of cattle finishing operations as of January 8, 2016. The calculation and projection process was updated in July of 2012. This process reflects a cash market situation without price risk management strategies being implemented. Each month updates are made to reflect the most recent feedlot closeout estimates and to reflect current market conditions.

Close-out Calculations

The most recent *Focus on Feedlots* survey provides information on lots closed out in November of 2015. As shown in figures 1 and 2, steers were estimated to be sold in November at substantial losses of (-\$499.64/hd) while heifers were also sold at losses (-\$483.13/hd). These November \$/hd losses are the largest on record in this series since January 2002.

Projected Returns

Given the one-month lag in *Focus on Feedlots* survey information, market information is available for December of 2015 but realized animal performance data are not yet available. Currently, the net returns projected for closeouts in December are losses of -\$571.07/hd and -\$527.59/hd for steers and heifers, respectively (tables 1 and 2). Tables 1 and 2 also present projected net returns for closeouts over the next nine months based on forecasts of both animal performance and market prices. These tables also include the projected and breakeven values for cattle prices and cost of gain which provide further insight into the sensitivity underlying these projections. Producers are encouraged to carefully compare their own costs and prices with those reported here. The projections suggest upcoming closeout months will improve yet remain negative until August. This improvement from the expected record setting losses in December, primarily reflects significant declines in projected feeder cattle placement prices. Finally, historical and breakeven values are provided in chart format revealing trends over time in fed cattle sales prices (figures 3 and 4), cost of gain (figures 5 and 6), and feeder cattle purchase prices (figures 7 and 8).
