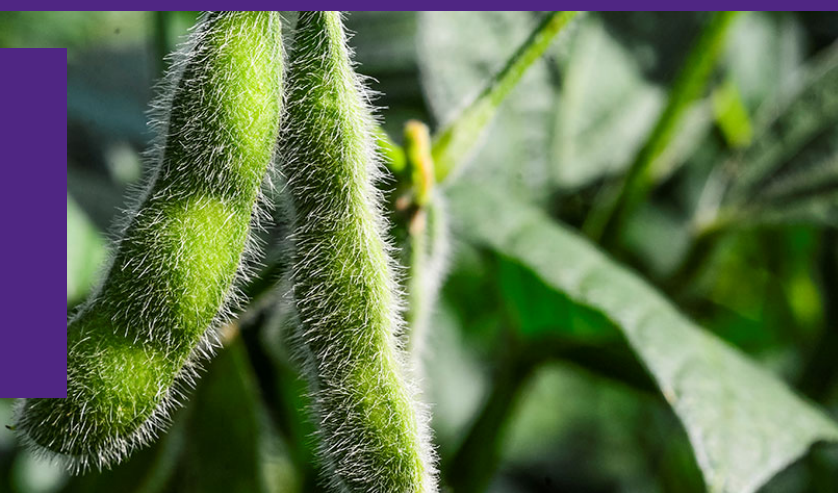

Ad Hoc Programs

- **American Relief Act – passed by Congress in December 2024**
 - Emergency Commodity Assistance Program (ECAP)
 - One-time **economic** assistance payment based on **2024 acres** planted
 - **\$10 Billion authorized, \$9.4 Billion paid out nationally***, Kansas = \$735 million*
 - Supplemental Disaster Relief Program (SDRP)
 - Assistance payments because of **natural disaster** related losses for **2023 and 2024 crop years**
 - Stage 1: Losses where a crop insurance indemnity was received
 - Stage 2: Shallow losses not triggering an insurance indemnity, quality losses, uncovered losses
 - Deadline for both extended to Sept. 30th, 2026
 - Original payments factored by 35%, **paid an additional 35% in April 2026**
 - **\$16 Billion authorized, \$13.4 Billion paid out nationally***, Kansas = \$1.4 billion*
 - Emergency Livestock Relief Program (ELRP)
 - “Top-up” to Livestock Forage Disaster Program (LFP) for 2023 and 2024 of 35%, **increased to 43.2% in Feb. 2026**
 - Kansas: \$528 million*

Ad Hoc Programs

- **Farmer Bridge Assistance (FBA)**
 - Announced by Trump Administration/USDA in Dec. 2025, *did not go through Congress*
 - Paid on planted acres from 2025
 - Paid out in March/April 2026
 - \$12 Billion authorized, \$10.5 Billion paid out nationally*, Kansas = \$793 million*

One Big Beautiful Bill Act

- Newly enhanced ARC and PLC for 2025 crops, paid October 2026
- New Base Acre Allocation
- Strategies for Electing ARC/PLC for 2026 Crop
- Crop Insurance

October ARC/PLC for 2025 Crop

- For the 2025 harvested crop **ONLY**, farmers will receive the higher of the calculated ARC or PLC payment
- Wheat, Oats and Barley marketing years ended May 31st, final payments are known
- Corn, Soybeans and Grain Sorghum marketing years end August 31st, prices will be known Sept. 29th

Calculating your PLC payment

Wheat example:

PLC Payment = \$1.29 per bushel * Program Yield * Wheat Base Acres * 85%

*\$1.29 per bushel * 45 bushels = \$58.05 per acre*

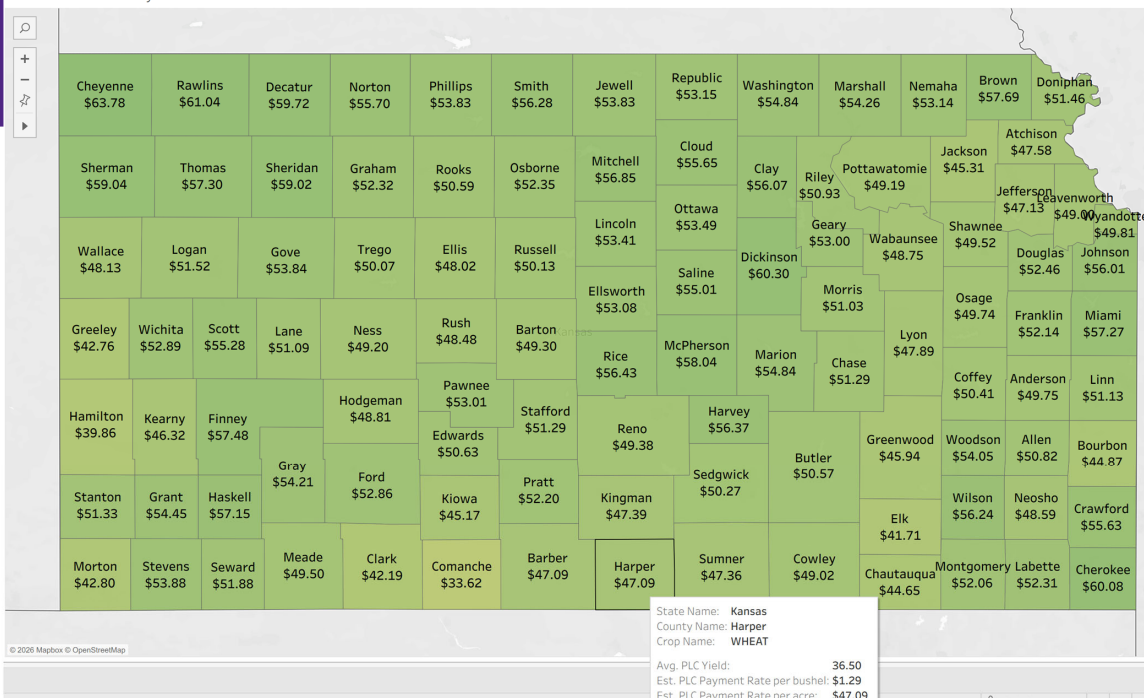
*\$58.05 per acre * 500 acres * 85% = \$24,671*

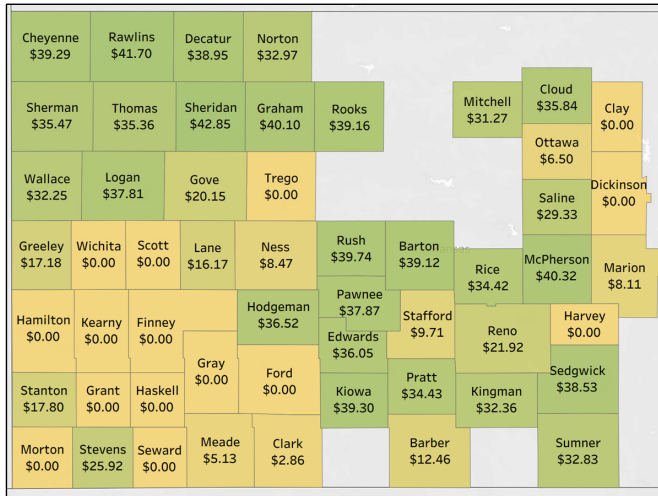


Estimated PLC Payments - WHEAT

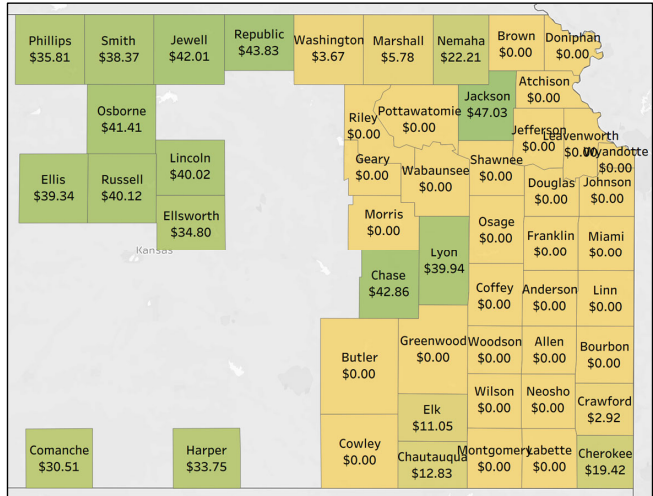


2025/2026 ARC Payment Maps

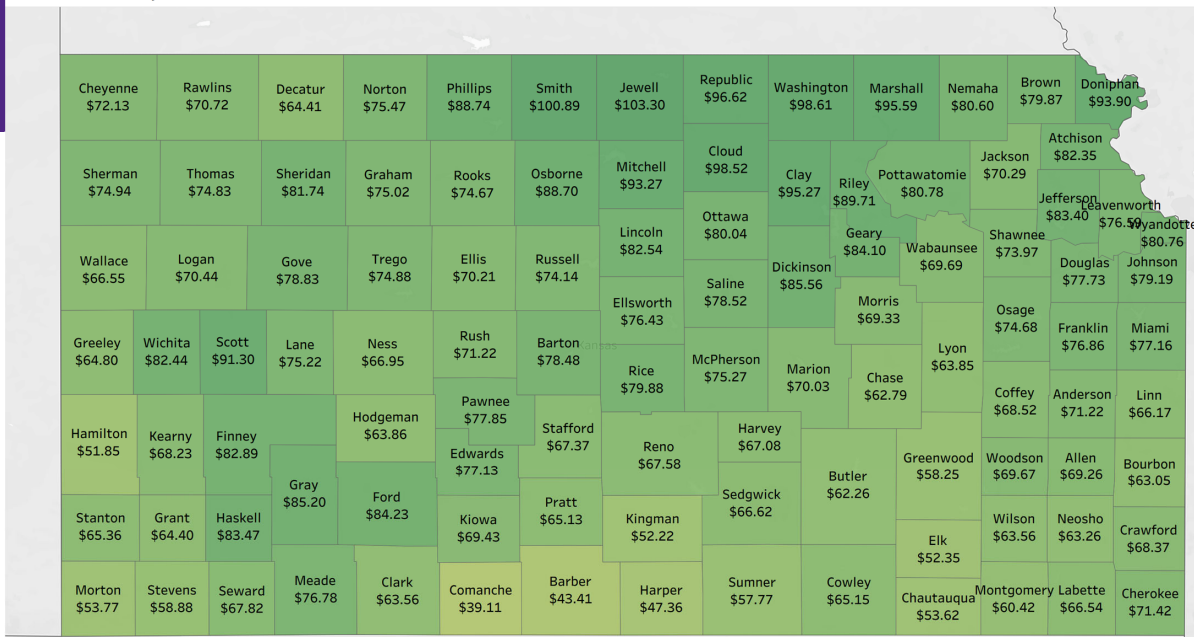
Non-Irrigated Wheat



Counties with combined Irr./Dryland

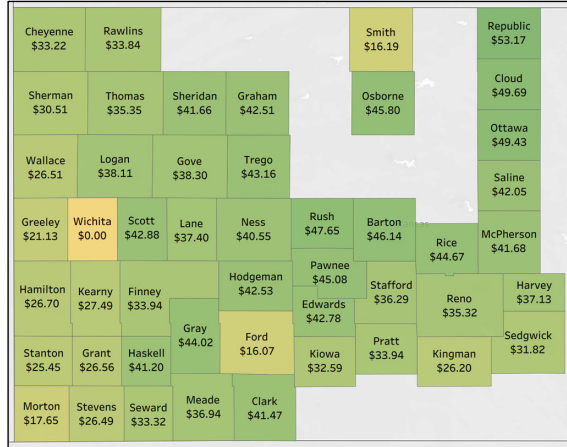


Estimated PLC Payments - GRAIN SORGHUM

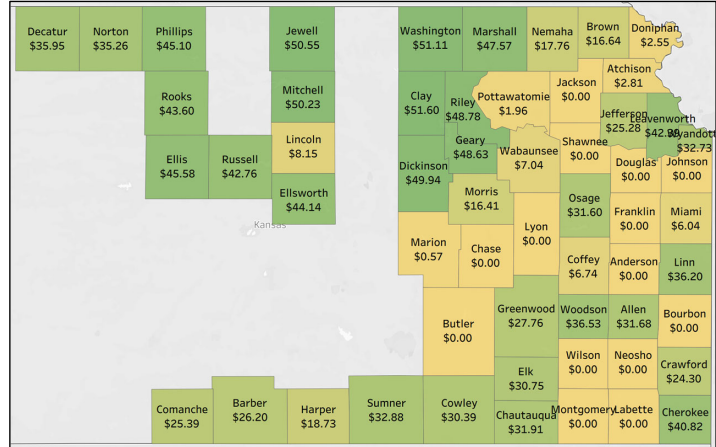

Estimated ARC & PLC Payments

The first Title I Farm Bill program payments that include the One Big Beautiful Bill Act enhancements will be received by farmers starting in October 2026, for the crop harvested in 2025. These payments are the one-time opportunity farmers have to receive the higher of the calculated Agricultural Risk Coverage (ARC) and Price Loss Coverage (PLC) programs, before going back to annual program elections, starting with this year's harvested crop.

PLC payments are based on Marketing Year Average (MYA) prices only, in which current forecasts will be very close to final numbers when they are released at the end of the marketing year. Wheat, oats, and barley MYA prices are now final, and corn, soybeans, and grain sorghum will be final on August 31st and announced in late September.

ARC-County payments are based on MYA prices (discussed above) and county yields. The following Maps show estimated ARC payments and accompanying paper explains how they are calculated:



New Base Acre Allocation

- 30 million more base acres allowed nationwide
- Allocated to farms that are planting more acres than they have in base acres
- New base acres will be assigned to covered commodities based on historical plantings 2019-2023
- Deadline is August 31st, 2026

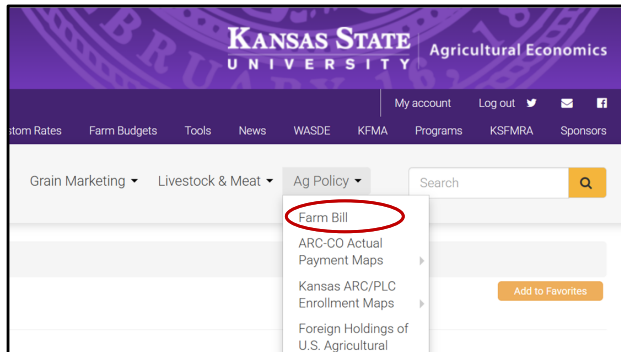

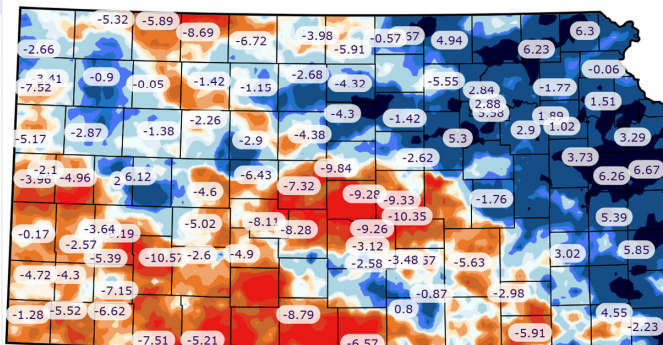

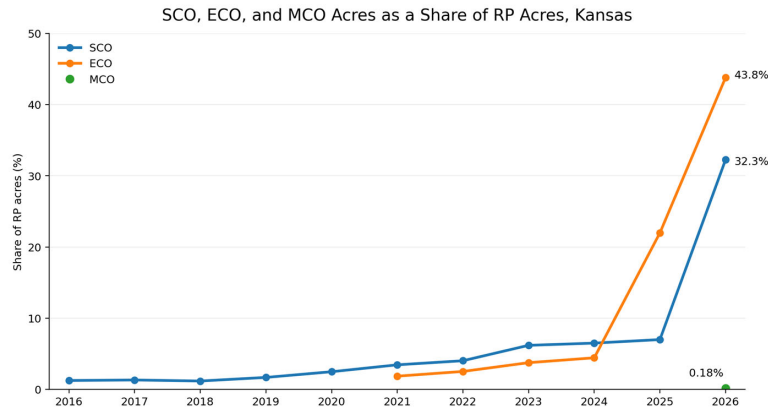

Crop Insurance

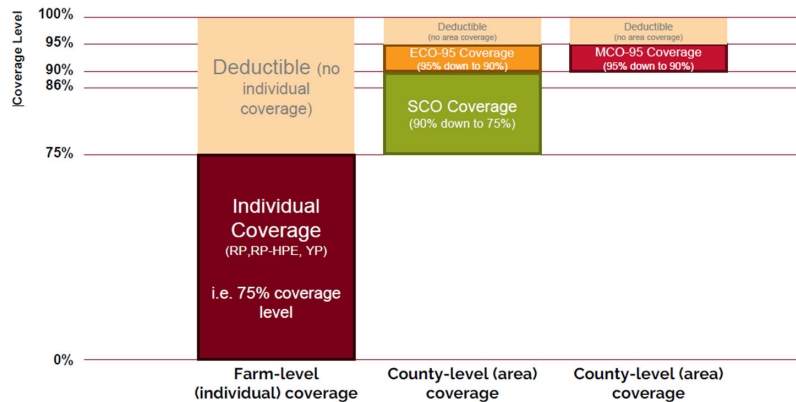
- OBBBA increased premium subsidy for supplemental area policies, participation increased in the 2026 crop year
- No major changes for 2027 crop year anticipated
 - SCO now covers up to 90% of expected yield or revenue
 - ECO and MCO now cover 90-95% yield or revenue (equivalent)

Supplemental Policy Refresher



SCO + ECO Refresher

- County-based trigger, pays out when county yields released around June of the following year
 - Guarantee is based on the farm, amount of loss is based on the county
- SCO increases underlying YP or RP coverage to 90%
- ECO (Enhanced Coverage Option) covers 90-95%

MCO Refresher

- Operating margin coverage
 - Similar but different than MP
 - Can be triggered by revenue decline and/or (select) input cost increases
- Can be used with SCO, but not ECO
- Deadline of September 30 for corn, cotton, grain sorghum, soybeans

Supplemental Policy Tradeoffs

Benefits

- 80% premium subsidy is highly favorable to the producer in the long run
- (More) predictable coverage of shallow losses

Concerns

- Paid out in June
- Tied to county yields
- Increases total premium cost substantially
- Can go a few years without triggering

MCO vs ECO

- Key difference
 - Price discovery Aug 15-Sept 14 vs Feb.
 - MCO payouts affected by input prices
- Payouts will usually be driven by revenue: early price discovery is a key consideration

New Farm Bill?

- House of Representatives passed “Food, Farm, and National Security Act of 2026” on April 30th
- Senate Ag Committee failed to advance a bill out of committee on Aug. 6th
 - Disputes over SNAP and cost sharing timeline for states
 - Try again in September
- 2018 Farm Bill expires Sept. 30th after it's third extension
