


#### Trade and US agri-food economy


- Five percent of the US GDP is attributed to the agri-food sector; \$1.053 trillion in 2017.
- U.S. agricultural exports were valued at \$140 billion in 2018 and \$136.65 billion in 2019.
- Major export commodities: soybean, corn, beef, pork and wheat.



#### **Timeline of COVID-19**













## **Export Value of Bulk Agricultural Products**






### **Export Value of Intermediate Agricultural Products**




### Kansas Exports of Bulk Products





### Kansas Export of Intermediate Products


